Dear Parents and Students in the Grades 9-11:

The purpose of this letter is to officially notify you of your right to participate in Ohio's College Credit Plus program for the 2019-2020 school year. The program has been established to permit students in grades seven through twelve to earn college and high school graduation credit through the successful completion of college courses. Students electing to participate in this program enroll in and attend college classes either during the regular school day or after school hours. Students may also continue to take classes at Avon Middle School and/or Avon High School, and, in all respects, remain students of the Avon School District.

Participation at Lorain County Community College and Cuyahoga Community College is subject to meeting the enrollment requirements for each college, and requires that accepted students take a placement test (the ACCUPLACER) or achieve a college ready score on the ACT/SAT before enrolling in CCP coursework.

College Credit Plus allows a student to receive both high school and college credit. For public high school students there is no transfer of tuition between student and college. The high school's state foundation pays the college directly. Public high school students electing this option will not be required to pay for tuition, books, materials or fees. **Families will be responsible for tuition costs should a student fail a course or drop a course after the college-established deadlines. Transportation to and from the college and the cost of said transportation is a family responsibility.**

The State of Ohio requires that **potential CCP participants and their parents** attend an informational meeting prior to applying for the CCP program. *Current CCP students and parents are not required to attend additional meetings; **only first time CCP students and their parents are required to attend a meeting.***

For your convenience, families may choose to attend one of the following meetings hosted by either LCCC or Cuyahoga Community College:

- **December 4, 2018 6:30-7:30pm-Avon High School (Co-hosted by LCCC & Tri-C)**

***\*Additional LCCC CCP meeting dates will be published on the AHS Website when available.***

A CCP application is considered complete when students have met the following requirements:

1. Attend a CCP informational meeting and return the Attendance Verification form to AHS Student Services Office by April 1, 2019
2. Request CCP during the online scheduling process at AHS
3. Complete and return a CCP program application to AHS Student Services
4. Take the ACCUPLACER placement test or send college ready ACT/SAT scores
5. Complete a Course Authorization form at AHS and schedule college courses at LCCC
6. Supply AHS counselor with an official copy of LCCC class schedule
7. Adhere to all program deadlines as established by the State of Ohio and the Avon Local Schools

Failure to complete any of the above steps will result in nonparticipation in the CCP program.

College Credit Plus is a worthwhile endeavor for eligible students. We are excited our students have the opportunity.
