



# AVON HIGH SCHOOL Junior / Senior Release Program

Avon High School's Junior / Senior Release program is given to students to help them develop responsibility for their unassigned period(s). Juniors and seniors are allowed to leave for two (2) designated periods as scheduled. This must be earned and may be lost if the student fails to follow the school rules and release guidelines.

## General Procedures

1. Junior / Senior Release will not be given unless this form is signed by the parents and student and is on file in the main office. Juniors and seniors must be taking five (5) courses each quarter to qualify for this program, be a good citizen of the school community and maintain a 2.0 grade point average.
2. Students must be in school or accounted for the official six-hour day. They may only leave during the release period on their contract and if found leaving at other times without school authorization, may face suspension and loss of their release.
3. Students may enter the building five (5) minutes before class but must remain in the entrance until the bell rings. Students may not go to their lockers until classes change.
4. Students who choose Junior / Senior Release must consistently leave the building during their release period every day of the semester during the period in which they choose release. Students will not be allowed to choose to leave the building one day, and remain in the building on another. Those students who wish to remain at Avon High School will be scheduled into study hall.
5. New opportunities for release will be at the beginning of each semester. New release forms must be completed at the beginning of each semester.

## Loss of Release Privileges

The following is a list of instances that will cause loss of release privileges for as long as the remainder of the school year:

1. Suspension and other discipline consequences at the discretion of the administration
2. Cutting class
3. Greater than ten (10) days absence (excluding doctor's excuses, court appearances, or funerals)
4. Excessive tardies
5. Returning late from release
6. Loitering in unauthorized areas of the school
7. Receiving an "F" in any class
8. Being in jeopardy of graduating or of failing a class
9. Remaining in parked cars or in the parking lot during release time
10. Misbehavior during free periods
11. Being on any other school grounds without authorization
12. Any other administrative reason

Participation in the release program is fully voluntary. Although students must follow both school rules and the rules/regulations of this program, Avon Schools will carry no liability for accident, injury, or a student's actions while a student is out of school on the Junior / Senior Release Program.
