
◇ STATE OF OHIO ASSESSMENTS:
MARCH 21st, APRIL 7th, MAY 2nd, 3rd, & 4th, 2017 ◇

The following is important information regarding Ohio's required assessments which will take place March through May, 2017. Participation in the Ohio Assessments is a state graduation requirement for the Class of 2017 in U.S. Government. The students in the Classes of 2018 and beyond are required to take seven end-of-course exams. In order to provide the optimal testing environment, we will follow the modified bell schedules provided on the reverse.

All students involved in testing are to report to school at 8:00am. Students are expected to be on time for testing and attendance is mandatory. Our staff and students have worked very hard to prepare for testing. A good night's sleep and breakfast have been found to be beneficial to students' test performance. Please try to avoid appointments during this time.

Thank you for your help in preparing your high school student for this important testing.

◇ WHICH STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO TEST? ◇

- 9th graders in Language Arts 9, Language Arts 9 Honors or 9th graders in CCP English
- 10th graders in Language Arts 10, Language Arts 10 Honors or 10th graders in CCP English
- 9th and 10th graders in Algebra I or Algebra I Foundations
- 9th and 10th graders in Geometry, Geometry Honors or Geometry Foundations
- 10th graders in American History or AP US History
- 11th graders are required to take the ACT exam
- 12th graders in second semester Government or AP Government



◇ IMPORTANT TESTING NOTES ◇

1. **There is no school for 10th and 12th grade students on March 21st.** Only students testing on March 21st are required to report to school.
2. Early Bird classes will not be held on March 21st.
3. Early Bird classes will be held on April 7th, May 2nd, 3rd, and 4th between 2:42pm and 3:10pm. Students who have both Early Bird and 9th period classes should report to Early Bird on Friday and Wednesday, and to 9th period on Tuesday and Thursday.
4. Junior / Senior release is still in session. See times of the release periods listed on the testing schedule.
5. CCP and TEE placements take priority over AHS courses. Students in CCP and TEE; however, may not miss the ACT³ test or State of Ohio assessments.
6. Attendance is **mandatory** for State of Ohio assessment testing and the ACT. Students absent on test dates will be rescheduled for testing.
7. On April 7th: Arrival to school between 11:59am – 12:27pm will be marked as tardy.
On April 7th: Arrivals at or after 12:28pm will be marked as ½ day absent.
On April 7th: Arrival after 1:58pm will be considered a full day absence.
