

IMPORTANT COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (CCP) INFORMATION

1. The program is open to incoming 7th graders through seniors.
2. Students must meet the entrance requirements set forth by the CCP institution.
3. Upon acceptance into the CCP program students will receive college credit and high school credit for each successfully completed course.
4. Students must notify the high school guidance department by April 1st of his or her intent to participate in CCP for the following academic year.
5. Students taking courses through College Credit Plus are not responsible for the cost of tuition, books, materials and fees provided they successfully complete the college course. In addition, students are required to return textbooks at the end of each semester. Students may be required to pay for any equipment that is kept, such as tools, calculators, etc.
6. Students are required to have a course authorization form completed by their high school guidance counselor prior to class registration at the college.
7. Once students register for courses at the college, they are required to provide their high school counselor with an official copy of their college schedule before the semester begins.
8. Students will receive 1 high school credit for each successfully complete 3-5 semester hour course. Courses that are less than 3 semester hours will receive proportional high school credit.
Ex: 1 semester hour course at the college = .33 credits at the high school
9. Students are limited to a total of 30 semester hours each academic year including the previous summer. This total is a combination of the semester hours for college courses and 3 times the high school credits.
10. Avon High School requires freshmen & sophomores to be enrolled in at least 6 classes each semester and juniors & seniors to be enrolled in at least 5 classes each semester.
11. The grades earned at the post-secondary institution will be averaged into the grade point average at the high school.
12. Students are responsible for transportation. Students **may** apply to be reimbursed for transportation if you meet the guidelines established by the State Board of Education.
13. Students receiving academic support at Avon High School may qualify for support at the post-secondary institution. It is the student's responsibility to contact the college for available support services for their college courses.
14. If there is a required state graduation examination for a course that a student chooses to take through CCP, students will be required to participate in that examination at Avon High School in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code. Students are responsible for notifying CCP instructors of required testing that may conflict with CCP class attendance.
