



## AVON EAGLES NEST SUMMER CAMPS 2019

***Registration will open on January 14<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 am. Registration fees will be required via credit card to complete. Remaining tuition costs will be collected 30 days prior to camp start date.***

**Hours of Camps:** 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM, Monday-Friday

*(Due to staffing and liability concerns, we must close at 5:30PM. Late pick ups are not permitted. A \$25 late charge will be invoiced for late pick ups. More than 3 late picks ups could result in forfeiting future camp enrollments.)*

**Location:** Camps will be held at Heritage NORTH

**Costs\*:** Tuition for 2 week camp is \$350; Tuition for a 1 week camp is \$175, Daily Camp Days are \$35 a day.

*Each camp has a separate registration fee which varies depending on field trip and activity costs.*

## SUMMER CAMP DESCRIPTIONS 2019

**Camp One (2 weeks): June 17 - June 28**

**Cost: \$30 Registration fee plus \$350**

**Camp Theme: Craft and Create**

This 2-week camp offers a variety of opportunities for children to express their creative side. We will focus on a variety of art forms and various specialty crafts using lots of different media. This camp is not ALL about art as we will also explore how we can be creative with science, engineering, music and theatre. **Daily Camp Days (3 days): July 1 – July 3 \*New this year\***

**Cost: Select the days you need one, two, or all three; \$35 daily rate (payment is due at time of registration, no registration fee)**

We will be offering Daily Camp Days during the week of July 1-July 3. You can register for 1, 2, or all 3 days; whatever your schedule requires. For these days, we will celebrate America with fun patriotic crafts and activities each day. We will not have any field trips on these days. You must pay the daily rate in full at the time of registration.

**Camp Two (2 weeks): July 8 - July 19**

**Cost: \$30 Registration fee plus \$350 camp Tuition Fee**

Every day we will enjoy our summer days with a variety of activities, crafts and fun summer themed events. Students will visit Mitchell's ice cream and also enjoy a Water Field Day. **Camp Three (2 weeks): July 22 - August 2**

**Cost: \$ 30 Registration plus \$350 camp Tuition Fee**

Avon Performing Arts will teach students music from the movie Moana with a showcase performance for parents and families to enjoy.
